COMPANY OVERVIEW

DC Falling and Construction Inc is a HUBZone-certified, SDVOSB-qualified forestry operations firm serving USFS Regions 4, 5, and 6. Founded by two owners with 50+ combined years in timber felling, hazard tree removal, and wildland fire suppression, DC Falling delivers industrial-scale logging and emergency tree work in remote, high-risk terrain, consistently finishing ahead of schedule. The company holds a California Licensed Timber Operator credential and maintains 24–48 hour mobilization readiness under USFS VIPR contract requirements.

 - Subcontracted felling and project supervision under prime North Fork Enterprises. Deployed 7-person felling crew; project estimated at 2 months – completed in 5 weeks.
